Peddler and Itinerant Merchant License Application

IMPORTANT DEFINITIONS

Itinerant Merchant – Any person who shall expose for sale, any goods, wares or articles of merchandise, not being a regular merchant of the town, and shall include any person who exposes his or her goods for sale in a flea market, a parking lot or an unused portion of a building or from any fixed location within the town.

Peddler – Any person engaged in the act of peddling of articles of merchandise.

Peddling – The sale or offering for sale from house to house by any persons from a cart, truck, automobile or other vehicle operated over and upon the streets and highways any articles of merchandise and shall include, without limitation, fresh fruits and vegetables, farm products, household medicines, remedies and other articles.

**All itinerant merchant and peddler licenses are valid for a period not to exceed six (6) months.*

By signing for this application, the applicant is acknowledging and agreeing to the following:

1. My business will not expose for sale, offer to sell, barter or exchange, or sell any foods, wares or articles of merchandise within the public street and highway rights-of-way, or on parking lots and other outdoor areas open to the public which are located wholly or in part within 25 feet of the rights-of-way.
2. My business will not sell articles of merchandise from a temporary location without obtaining written permission from the owner of that location to temporarily locate on the property for the purpose of selling articles of merchandise.
3. My business will not sell articles of merchandise from a vehicle or place or locate a vehicle in a parking lot of a business establishment, unless and excepting the remaining parking spaces in the parking lot, not occupied by my business, are at least equal to and not less than the parking required for that business establishment under the zoning laws of the town.
4. My business will locate only in those areas in which there is sufficient room for my business vehicle(s) and the parking of a minimum of three (3) automobiles for customers on the premises where my business is located or in designated on-street parking areas.
5. My business will remove its vehicle(s) from the premises after normal business hours, and will not allow its vehicle(s) or trailer(s) to remain on the premises between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.
6. My business will not peddle any articles of merchandise from any vehicle or on foot or by any other means between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. in any residential zoning district within the corporate limits of Seagrove.
7. Vehicles that my business sells articles of merchandise from shall not be located within the minimum front, side or rear yards required in the zoning district in which the vehicle is located.
8. My business may not use more than one (1) attached sign to advertise, identify or locate itself. The sign must be attached to the vehicle or structure from which the business operates. The sign must not exceed ten (10) square feet in area and the sign will be exhibited only during the times that the business is operating.
9. My business does not present a danger to the public health, safety, morals, or general welfare of the citizens of Seagrove.
10. My business is in compliance with all relevant federal and state bonding and licensing requirements.
11. My business is in compliance with all local, county, state, and federal laws.
12. If issued a Peddlers and Itinerant Merchant License, I understand that the license is valid only for the period indicated and is not transferable or assignable.
13. I understand that the license must be displayed during all hours of business operation.
14. The information supplied on this form is true to the best of my knowledge.
